Annual Report (2020-21)



Followings are the Academic and Extra-Curricular activities of the session:

The normal classes for the new academic sessions disrupted due to the prevalent pandemic situation despite admission of new students through online mode under Bodoland University in September. However, few classes were held with strict observance of Covid – 19 SoP circulated by the government.

During unlock period, Women Cell organized an Exhibition cum Sale from 8th April to 9th April 2021 to encourage and promote local artisans. During the programme a cultural rally and extempore speech competition among the students was organised and prizes were distributed among the three selected best performers. Two days exhibition cum sale of handicraft products saw turning up of many local artisans with their beautiful products. The programme was inaugurated by Hon'ble G.B. President Mr Dwijen Chaudhary. The programme was divided into three segments namely, exhibition cum sale of ethnic foods, handicrafts and traditional outfit, and traditional dress competition among the students. Different types of ethnic foods were exhibited by students and communities of Mazbat area. Some handcrafted bamboo products were also exhibited by few local artists. On the last day, the 9th of April a colourful cultural rally was organised by the students of the college. Among them 7 (seven) students were selected as best performers by judges and prizes were distributed among them.

Followings are the Academic and Extra-Curricular activities of the session:

Due to all pervading pandemic situation, the college largely remained closed till August 2021. As the pandemic gradually subsided the normal academic curriculum and activities gradually resumed by September with the beginning of new academic session. The admission of new students took place in an online mode. The classes for all the three odd semesters begun in safe and secured way by maintaining social distance, wearing face-mask and washing hands by sanitizer but the attendance of students was voluntary.

Meantime, other co-curricular activities like field work, educational trips etc were undertaken by different departments of the college.The University examination for 1st semester was held in online mode conducted by Bodoland University in the month of Setember.
