### **ADMISSION REQUIREMENTS AND PROCEDURE**

Application for admission into the College should be made in the prescribed form within the stipulated date as per notice. No application will be accepted after the last date of submission. Students will be selected strictly on the basis of merit. Seats are also reserved for students belonging to SC, ST(P), ST(H), OBC, MOBC as per Govt. rules. Candidate must attach the Self Attested photocopies of the following documents with application form. Mark Sheet of the last qualifying examination. Pass Certificate from the Head of the Institution last attended. Caste Certificate wherever necessary. Two copies of the Passport size photograph. H.S. Registration Card (Photostate copy). Students Passing the qualifying exam. Earlier to the Current year must submit a Gap Certificate testifying their activities during last year (s). Students are required to produce all original documents from H.S.L.C. onwards at the time of admission. The decision of the "Admission Committee" will be final for any dispute.

**N.B.- Incomplete application form in any respect will summarily be rejected.**



## RULES AND REGULATIONS



1. Academic session starts at the college as per Gauhati University regulations.
2. College uniform is compulsory for all the students.  
For Boys : Black Pants (Formal), Sky Blue Shirts. Winter-wear : Black sweater/ Black blazer  
For Girls : White salwar, Sky Blue Kameez & White Dupatta. Winter-wear: Black sweater/ Black blazer
3. It is mandatory for students to bring Identity Cards.
4. Students must attend **75%** of classes, otherwise they will not be allowed to sit as regular candidate either in the college or university examination.
5. Students who fail to attend their classes on genuine and acceptable grounds such as serious disease or accidents and related treatment involving the students themselves and the members of the family, death of near and dear ones, academic / sports / cultural activities approved by the College, must apply to the Head of the Department concerned within 24 hours for consideration of leave of absence for the said period. Application must be supported with testimonials / documents whichever is necessary. Even for such cases the actual attendance must not be less than 50%.
7. Students must appear in all the examinations conducted by the college during an academic session.
8. Students must maintain discipline inside the college, violation of the rules and regulations in any form will invite disciplinary action.
9. Students found indulging in ragging or any such activities will be punished as per legal provision.
10. Maintenance of discipline is vested with the Disciplinary Committee headed by the Principal and his/her decision shall be final in all matters.
11. Filled up Registration Forms should be submitted to the College Office within the stipulated time as fixed. No Registration Form will be received after that.
